



Christmas Tree Drop-Off

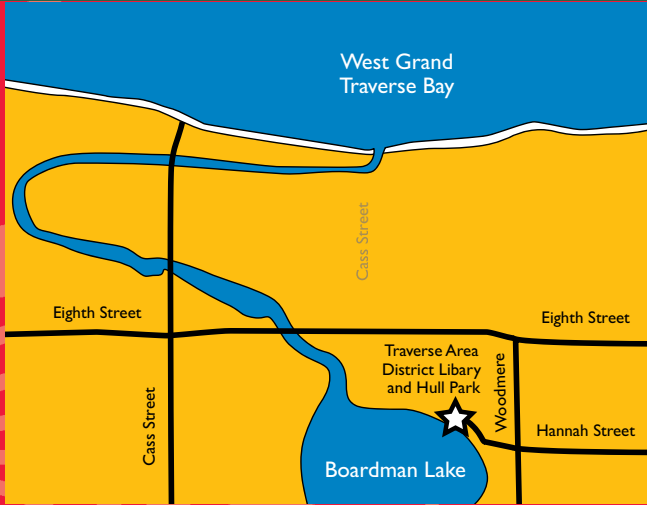
Traverse City Light & Power and the Traverse City Parks and Recreation Division will be accepting used Christmas trees for recycling. Here are details:

You should bring your trees to Hull Park, located behind the Traverse Area District Library, at the end of Hannah Street. Follow the Christmas Tree Drop-Off signs to the boat parking lot of Hull Park.

Drop trees off between: 8 a.m. – 5 p.m. Monday, December 26 – Saturday, January 21, 2006.

Park crews will chip and recycle trees as mulch for use on nature trails.

Please don't leave your Christmas trees in alleys or on streets; the city will NOT collect them.

Safety Tips for Holiday Lights

Decorating a tree or an object outdoors with electrical lights can add to your festivities this season IF you follow some important safety tips. Here's a sample:

1 Check each set of lights, new or old, for broken or cracked sockets, frayed or bare wires, or loose connections. Discard damaged sets or repair them before using.

2 Before using lights outdoors, check labels to be sure they have been certified for outdoor use. To hold lights in place, string them through hooks or insulated staples, not nails or tacks. Never pull or tug lights to remove them.

3 Turn off all lights when you go to bed or leave the house. The lights could short out and start a fire.
