Project Name: Electric Utility Vegetation Management Plan

This addendum will answer any questions/clarifications submitted to-date. Any additional questions received by the deadline of November 1, 2022 as stipulated in the RFP will be answered in a subsequent addendum.

- 1. Are any of your 24 miles of transmission miles regulated by NERC, if so, how many miles?**

No/None.

- 2. Due to the size of your system, are you looking for a full inventory or general high-level assessment of field conditions?**

We are looking for a general assessment of what a utility of this size in this area should have for vegetation management resources, and how those resources would be best be utilized (e.g., a cycle of x period, how to handle or staff for emergent non-cycle work). One year ago, we began a 5-year cycle field inspection program that identifies vegetation clearance issues which has indicated that we likely need to change how we are managing this program. Ideally, if we get on a vegetation trimming cycle, the inspection would follow the trimming. The RFP has a separate line item to quote for an optional field assessment.

- 3. Have you in the past or are you interested in acquiring LIDAR for your system?**

We have discussed LIDAR with a vendor previously; however, as we will have field personnel looking at all of our facilities every 5 years at a minimum, a financial decision was made to rely on their inspection for vegetation management and joint use issues.

- 4. The RFP states to complete ONLY Section C – Iran Economic Sanctions Act, and Section E – Submission. Should bidders utilize “Attachment A” to submit the scope of services, etc., or is it allowable to submit a formal bid packet with proposal, resumes, etc. in addition to the required completed Section C and Section E forms?**

Bidders may submit a formal bid packet with their proposals, and any supporting documentation that addresses the Scope of Work and Deliverables defined in Section A III of the RFP, so long as it includes the required Section C and Section E forms from the RFP packet.
