New Green Rate Option

TCL&P residential and commercial customers now have the option to participate in a Voluntary Green Pricing Renewable Energy Program (VGP). Customers can elect to offset their energy consumption by 25, 50, 75 or 100 percent with renewable energy sources such as wind and solar.

The new VGP program, as required by Public Act 342, gives customers the opportunity to support a greater level of investment in renewable energy technologies. When joining, customers agree to pay an extra \$.0085 cents per kilowatt-hour. To an average residential customer who elects to go 100% and whose monthly consumption is 523 kWh, they would see an increase on their utility bill of \$4.45.

2017 Annual Customer Summary

Energy Waste Reduction (EWR) Report Summary - MPSC Case Number U-18317

Again this year, TCL&P contracted with Franklin Energy through the Michigan Public Power Agency (MPPA) to administer EWR efforts in order to comply with 2008 PA 295, as amended by 2016 PA 342. The Michigan Municipal Electric Association (MMEA) filed a biennial 2-year EWR Plan with the Michigan Public Service Commission (MPSC) on August 1, 2017 and filed a joint 2017 EWR Annual Report for TCL&P with the MPSC on May 31, 2018.

In 2017, TCL&P spent \$409,902 on EWR Programs and achieved 2,926 MWh of energy savings.

Renewable Energy Report Annual Summary - MPSC Case Number U-16635

TCL&P filed A 20-year Renewable Energy Plan (REP) with the MPSC on March 31, 2009 as required by PA 295 and it was found to be in compliance on July 1, 2009. Then on December 1, 2017, TCL&P filed a Biennial Review of the REP and it was found to be in compliance by the MPSC on April 12, 2018.

TCL&P acquired from renewable energy systems during the reporting period 34,972 MWh of renewable energy. TCL&P acquired 34,973 Renewable Energy Credits (RECs) and 960 incentive-Renewable Energy Credits (iRECs) for the 2017 reporting period.
