Net Billing Rate

TCLP offers a net billing rate structure designed to encourage customer-generated energy. This rate reflects seasonal on-peak and off-peak pricing, potentially offering higher outflow credits than traditional flat net metering, while supporting a community-owned, customer-focused energy model.



Customer Generation Program

TCLP has established a formal application, approval and contract process for customer generation, detailed in the utility's Rules Regulations located at <u>Microsoft Word - POLICY - Rules and Regulations</u>. Solicitor understands that TCLP reserves the right to accept any or all Responses in whole or in part and to waive irregularities in any response in the best interest of TCLP. The responses will be evaluated and awarded based upon the best value to TCLP. Criteria used will include, but not be limited to, solicitor/Successful Solicitor's ability, qualifications, experience, type and amount of equipment, purchase price, maintenance cost(s), insurance, resale, license and permits and overall capability meeting the needs of TCLP. TCLP is sales tax exempt – Government.

Solicitor shall pay all sales, consumer, use and other similar taxes required to be paid by Solicitor in accordance with the Laws and Regulations of the place of the Project which are applicable during the performance of the work.

 - iv. A violation of federal, local, or state civil rights, equal rights, or non-discrimination laws, rules or regulations.
 - v. Repeated or flagrant violations of laws related to the payment of wages and fringe benefits.
- f) the loss of a license or the right to do business or practice a profession, the loss or suspension of which indicates dishonesty, a lack of integrity, or a failure or refusal to perform in accordance with the ethical standards of the business or profession in question.
